ORDINANCE NO. 256

AN ORDINANCE NAMING 1620-1700 EAST 7000 SOUTH IN COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS AS “STAKER WAY”

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. §10-8-32 authorizes Utah municipalities to “name streets, courts, parks, thoroughfares and other public places and change the names thereof;”and

WHEREAS, § 12.28.040 of the Code of Ordinances of the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) authorizes the City to add to, change or correct the names of streets in the City by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, most residents of 7000 South between 1620 and 1700 East have informed the City that they desire for that street (the “Street”) to be named “Staker Way;” and

WHEREAS, the City’s community development director has informed the City’s city council (the “Council”) that so naming the Street may assist emergency vehicles to distinguish the Street from Fort Union Blvd., which also is sometimes called 7000 South; and

WHEREAS, the Council met in regular session on 24 May 2016 to consider, among other things, naming the Street “Staker Way” as requested; and

WHEREAS, no contrary viewpoints have been received by the City, and the Council believes that so naming the Street would be in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights as follows:

Section 1. **Naming of Street.** The Council hereby names 1620-1700 East 7000 South as “Staker Way.”

Section 2. **Action of Officers.** All actions of the officers, agents and employees of the City that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this ordinance (this “*Ordinance*”), whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 3. **Severability.** All parts of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. **Repealer.** All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance, assigned no. 256, shall take immediate effect as soon as it shall be published or posted as required by law and deposited and recorded in the office of the City’s recorder, or such later date as may be required by Utah statute.
