RESOLUTION NO. 2014-42

A RESOLUTION AWARDING A BADGE AND SELLING A SIDEARM FOR NOMINAL VALUE TO RETIRED CHPD OFFICER RANDY MAURER

WHEREAS, §2.150.060 of the COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS CODE OF ORDINANCES (the “Code”) establishes the procedures for disposal by the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) of its surplus property; and

WHEREAS, Officer Randy Maurer (“*Officer Maurer*”) has served the Cottonwood Heights Police Department (the “*CHPD*”) with honor since its inception in July 2008, distinguishing himself among his peers in his service to the community and in the City’s finest tradition; and

WHEREAS, Officer Maurer is retiring from the CHPD effective 1 July 2014; and

WHEREAS, Code §2.150.060(H)(2) provides that in connection with the retirement of an officer from the CHPD, following recommendation by the CHPD’s chief (the “*Chief*”), the City’s city council (the “*Council*”) may award the retiree his badge as a memento of his service to the City and/or allow the retiree to purchase his pistol or other sidearm (“*Sidearm*”) from the City for such consideration as the Council deems appropriate, which may be less than the Sidearm’s fair-market value; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the retirement of Officer Maurer, the Chief has recommended that the Council award Officer Maurer his badge and allow Officer Maurer to purchase his City-issued sidearm (specifically, a Springfield 1911 45ACP firearm with serial number NM234703, called herein the “*Sidearm*”) for the sum of \$10; and

WHEREAS, the Council met on 24 June 2014 to consider, among other things, awarding Officer Maurer his Badge as a memento of his honorable and diligent service to the City and authorizing sale of the Sidearm to Officer Maurer for \$10, as recommended by the Chief; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to so act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cottonwood Heights city council as follows:


1. The Council hereby expresses deep appreciation to Officer Maurer for his honorable and diligent service to the City and its residents for the past six years; and
2. The Council hereby awards Officer Maurer his badge as a memento of his service to the City; and

3. The Council hereby agrees to sell the Sidearm to Officer Maurer for \$10, "AS IS," and authorizes the Chief to consummate such sale on behalf of the City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2014-42, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
