RESOLUTION No. 2016-20

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
ACQUISITION OF PUBLIC WORKS VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Utah municipalities are authorized to provide a variety of municipal services within their boundaries, including public works services such as repair and maintenance of roadways; maintaining roadways reasonably clear of snow, ice and debris ("*snow plowing*"); pavement striping and painting of crosswalks and symbols; traffic sign installation; and repairs to sidewalks, curbs and gutters (collectively, "*public works services*"); and

WHEREAS, although most Utah municipalities self-provide many or all of their required public works services, since its incorporation in January 2005, most of the public works services within the city of Cottonwood Heights (the "*City*") have been performed for the City by contract providers, including Salt Lake County and Terracare Associates, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the City's city council (the "*Council*") anticipates that the City will begin self-providing most or all of its required public works services in approximately October 2016; and

WHEREAS, such self-provision will require the City to purchase or lease certain equipment, including trucks and other vehicles used primarily for snow plowing ("*snow plows*"); and

WHEREAS, securing adequate snow plows by October 2016 will require commitments by City to purchase or lease such vehicles so that they can be manufactured, equipped and delivered before that date; and

WHEREAS, the Council met on 12 April 2016 to consider, among other things, authorizing the City to purchase, to lease and/or to commit to the future purchase or lease of up to 14 snow plows, consisting of ten-wheel dump trucks, bobtails (single axle, five-yard dump trucks) and one-ton pickup trucks, with appropriate plows and equipment (the "*Equipment*"), including, without limitation, the Equipment described on the attached exhibit; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to authorize the City to so act;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cottonwood Heights city council that the City is authorized to purchase, to lease and/or to commit to the future purchase or lease of the Equipment on such terms as may be approved by the City's mayor in consultation with the City's manager, assistant manager, public works director and attorney.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2016-20, shall take effect immediately upon passage.


