RESOLUTION NO. 2016-77

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH  
UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CONVERTED  
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM PROJECT FUNDS  
(BIG COTTONWOOD TRAIL)

**WHEREAS**, Utah Department of Transportation (“*UDOT*”) makes available grants of converted transportation alternative program (“*TAP*”) funds for qualifying local projects within the state of Utah; and

**WHEREAS**, UDOT desires to grant up to \$100,000 in converted TAP funds to the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”) for use in completing the Big Cottonwood trail in the City, as contemplated by a “Cooperative Agreement-Converted TAP Funds for Local Agency” (the “*Agreement*”) submitted by UDOT to the City for approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the city council (the “*Council*”) of the City met in regular session on 13 September 2016 to consider, among other things, approving the City’s entry into the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has reviewed the form of the Agreement, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City’s residents to approve the City’s entry into the Agreement as proposed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the city council of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Agreement with UDOT is hereby approved, and that the City’s mayor and recorder are authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of the City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2016-77, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
