## RESOLUTION No. 2017-45

### A RESOLUTION AWARDING RETIRING POLICE OFFICERS THEIR BADGES AND APPROVING THEIR PURCHASE OF POLICE SIDEARMS

**WHEREAS**, §2.150.060 of the COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS CODE ("*Code*") establishes the procedures for disposal by the city of Cottonwood Heights (the "*City*") of its surplus property; and

**WHEREAS**, under Code §2.150.060(H)(2)(a)-(b), the Council may, by resolution following recommendation by the City's chief of police ("*Chief*"), award a retiring City police officer his badge and allow a retiring City police officer to purchase his sidearm from the City for such consideration as the Council deems appropriate; and

**WHEREAS**, Code §2.150.060(H)(3) provides that conveyances of equipment under Code §2.150.060(H) may occur without compliance with the surplusing and sale procedures applicable to other types of City property; and

**WHEREAS**, City police officers Lt. Mark Askerlund, Sgt. Ken Eatchel and Officer Sam Dawson (each, an "*Officer*") are retiring from the City's police department, and each desires to obtain his City police badge ("*Badge*") and to purchase his City-issued sidearm ("*Sidearm*"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief has recommended that the Council should award each Officer his Badge and allow (a) Lt. Askerlund to purchase his Sidearm (a Springfield Model 1911, .45 caliber pistol with serial no. NM239217) from the City for \$10.00, (b) Sgt. Eatchel to purchase his Sidearm (a Springfield Model 1911, "Operator", with serial no. LW118047) from the City for \$10.00, and (c) Officer Dawson to purchase his Sidearm (a Glock Model 22/Gen 4, 9mm semi-automatic pistol with serial no. SZH962) from the City for \$10.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council met on 27 June 2017 to consider, among other things awarding each Officer his Badge and allowing each Officer to purchase his Sidearm from the City for \$10.00; and


**WHEREAS**, after reviewing the Chief's recommendation and careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to award each of the Officers his Badge and approve each Officer's purchase of his sidearm from the City for \$10.00 in accordance with Code § 2.150.060(H)(2)(a)-(b);

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cottonwood Heights city council that each Officer is awarded his Badge and is authorized to purchase his Sidearm from the City for \$10.00.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2017-45, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
