

# COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS

## RESOLUTION No. 2017-61

### A RESOLUTION APPROVING A FEE INCREASE FOR THE WASATCH FRONT WASTE AND RECYCLING DISTRICT (EFFECTIVE 1 JANUARY 2018)

**WHEREAS**, the Wasatch Front Waste and Recycling District (the "*District*") is empowered by UTAH CODE ANN. 17D-1-210 and by Salt Lake County Resolution No. 4670 dated 20 November 2012 as amended by Salt Lake County Resolution No. 5100 (collectively, the "*Resolution*") to provide garbage collection and recycling services within the District's boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Cottonwood Heights (the "*City*") is included within the District's boundaries, and the City's residents receive services from the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Resolution provides that an increase in the District's service charges is not effective until a majority of the governing bodies that have representation on the District's Administrative Control Board (the "*Board*") have authorized such increase in writing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has recommended increases, effective 1 January 2018, to the current service fees charged by the District as follows: (a) an increase of \$2.25/month to the base fee, resulting in a base service fee of \$17.00/month; (b) an increase of \$2.00/month for each additional garbage can, resulting in a fee of \$17.00/month for each additional garbage can; and (c) a new services fee of \$3.00/month for each additional recycling can; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has requested that the City approve those increases (collectively, the "*Increase*") based on the Board's conclusion that the Increase is necessary based on projected increased costs identified and discussed by the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's municipal council (the "*Council*") met in regular session on 14 November 2017 to consider, among other things, approving the Increase; and


**WHEREAS**, the Council has reviewed the basis for the Increase and, after careful consideration, has determined that approving the Increase is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights that the Increase be, and hereby is, approved, and that the City's mayor and recorder are authorized and directed to execute and deliver such further evidences of such approval as may be reasonably proposed by either the City or the District.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2017-61, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
