## RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02

**WHEREAS**, consequently, the Council desires to express appreciation to, and to honor Tee for, his diligent and selfless work on behalf of the City and its residents;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Cottonwood Heights city council that the heartfelt appreciation of the City is hereby given to Tee W. Tyler for his efforts on behalf of the City as a city councilmember for the past eight years, with due acknowledgement of the support freely given by Tee's wife Debbie and their children and grandchildren to make such efforts possible.
