RESOLUTION No. 2018-76

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ENTRY INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT THROUGH THE UTAH COMMISSION ON CRIMINAL AND JUVENILE JUSTICE

WHEREAS, under the federal Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (the "Program"), local governmental entities can become eligible for certain grant funds upon entry into the Program's required certifications and agreements ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the city of Cottonwood Heights (the "City") has received for its consideration and possible adoption an Agreement for the Program's 2017 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City's municipal council (the "Council") met in regular session on 18 December 2018 to consider, among other things, approving the City's entry into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the form of the Agreement, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to approve the City's entry into the Agreement as proposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Agreement be, and hereby is, approved, and that the City's manager is authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of the City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2018-76, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
