ORDINANCE No. 303

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART 7 OF CHAPTER 2.140, COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS CODE, CONCERNING THE PARKS, TRAILS AND OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, on 27 March 2018, the city council (the “*Council*”) of the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “*City*”) enacted its Ordinance No. 294 amending chapter 2.140 (“*Chapter 2.140*”) of the COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS CODE OF ORDINANCES (the “*Code*”) to add a new Part 7, comprising Sections 2.140.701 through 2.140.705, concerning creation and operation of the Parks, Trails and Open Space Committee (the “*Committee*”) as one of the City’s advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, Code Section 2.140.703(B) currently provides that the Committee shall consist of up to 11 members, of which at least nine are City residents; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City to amend Code Section 2.140.703(B) to allow the Committee to include up to 15 members, of which at least 13 are City residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights as follows:

Section 1. **Amendment of Code Section 2.140.703(B)**. The Council hereby amends Code Section 2.140.703(B) to provide that the Committee shall consist of up to 15 members, of which at least 13 are City residents.

Section 2. **Action of Officers**. All actions of the officers, agents and employees of the City that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this ordinance (this “*Ordinance*”), whether taken before or after the adoption hereof, are hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 3. **Severability**. It is hereby declared that all parts of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs, clauses or provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. **Repealer**. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5. **Effective Date**. This Ordinance, assigned no. 294, shall take immediate effect as soon as it shall be published or posted as required by law and deposited and recorded in the office of the City’s recorder, or such later date as may be required by Utah statute.
