



## Cottonwood Heights Youth Banner Contest Contest Rules

The city of Cottonwood Heights is seeking talented youth to create drawings (without words) describing/representing the city. Winning drawings will be reproduced on banners to be displayed in the city during January 2015 honoring the city's tenth anniversary. Entries will be judged by a city selection committee on the basis of compliance with contest rules and theme, artistic merit, and utility for reproduction on the banners. The selection committee will choose up to four drawings from elementary school-aged applicants (5-12); up to six drawings from middle school-aged applicants (12-15); and up to six drawings from high school-aged applicants (15-18). Prizes will be awarded to the winners on 16 January 2015 at the opening of the city's birthday celebration at Butler Middle School. All entries will be displayed that night and the following day at the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center.

**Entry in this contest grants permission by the applicant and the applicant's parents (if the applicant is under 18) to the city to freely reproduce and use the entered artwork on the banners, in the city's newsletter and other publications, on the city's website, etc., as desired by the city in connection with the promotion, advertising, reporting, etc. of this contest.**

**Eligibility.** The contest is open to all school children aged 5-18 residing or attending school in Cottonwood Heights. The artwork must describe or represent Cottonwood Heights, past or present. Only one entry per applicant.

**Size and Medium.**

Only two-dimensional (2D) artwork on poster board measuring 15 inches wide and 36 inches in length will be accepted. Entries are to be drawings only, without words.

All artwork must be hand-made by the applicant using any one or more of the following media: Paints (watercolor, acrylic or oil); markers; colored pencils; charcoal; pastels; crayons.

**The following forms of media are NOT permitted:** Photographs; computer-generated artwork; or collage work.

**Retrieval.** Entries must be picked up at the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center (7500 South 2700 East) after 18 January 2014 until 25 January 2014. Entries not retrieved by 25 January 2014 may be disposed of without further notice.

**Mandatory Entry Form.** Please affix the following entry form to the back of the artwork, secured by tape. An incomplete or missing form will result in disqualifications of the entry. Entries are to be submitted at Cottonwood Heights' city offices (1265 East Fort Union Blvd., Suite 250) or the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center (7500 South 2700 East). Entries will ONLY be accepted from 22 November 2014 through 1 December 2014.
