# A DECLARATION OF THE COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS BOARD OF CANVASSERS APPROVING THE CANVASS OF THE 2023 COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**WHEREAS**, on 21 November 2023 the city of Cottonwood Heights (the "City") held a municipal general election (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(a), the City's mayor and municipal legislative body comprise the City's board of municipal canvassers (the "Board") for the Election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(b), the Board is required to meet to canvass the returns of the Election at the usual place of meeting of the City's municipal legislative body no sooner than seven days and no later than 14 days after the Election; and

WHEREAS, on 5 December 2023 the Board met in the meeting room of the City's city council (the "Council") for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the Election; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Election, and the voting therein, were conducted in compliance with Utah state law;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, **BE IT DECLARED** by the board of municipal canvassers of the city of Cottonwood Heights as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby accepts and approves the conduct and results of the Election.

Each member of the Board has reviewed the Report to ensure that it is correct, and by their affirmative vote below, authorizes and directs the City's mayor and recorder to sign, record, publish and file the Report as required by UTAH CODE ANN. §20A-4-301(2)(c).

Section 6. By their signature below, the Recorder, as the City's election officer, also certifies that the information contained in the Report is accurate.

This Declaration, assigned no. 2023-02, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
