Notice is hereby given that the CITY OF COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS (OWNER) will accept bids for the construction of the City Project 006.23 - PROSPECTOR DRIVE AREA ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - according to Drawings and Specifications prepared by the ENGINEER, and described in general as:

The work includes furnishing all labor, tools, materials, equipment, transportation, and services required for the construction of the below described project, located in Cottonwood Heights.

Work for this improvement project (Project # 006.23) consists of the following items of work: reconstruction of miscellaneous structures to grade; asphalt removal; concrete removal; curb and gutter removal, placing and compacting new asphalt surface course; rebuild curb and gutter; rebuild ADA crossings; rebuild concrete waterways; paint striping, messages; and all appurtenant work; all in accordance with Drawings and Specifications prepared by the Engineer.

CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be examined beginning on January 15th at 11:00 AM at the City Offices, 2277 E. Bengal Blvd, Cottonwood Heights or using the Utah Public Procurement Website, (bids.scquest.com). Separate sealed bids will be received by the OWNER in their office located at 2277 East Bengal Boulevard, Cottonwood Heights, Utah 84121 until 2:00 p.m. on February 6th, 2024 and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed and delivered to Cottonwood Heights Recorder, prior to the Bid Opening.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the base bid will be required to accompany bids.
