








## District 1 Property Crimes October 2023







#### Thanksgiving driving tips from AAA

- •Get a full vehicle inspection before setting out on your trip.
- •Leave early and allow extra time to get to your destination, so you are not in a rush.
- •Identify alternate routes in case you encounter congestion or road closures.
- •Avoid distractions while driving. Program your GPS before your drive.
- •Ensure everyone in the vehicle wears their seat belt.
- •Never drive impaired.

#### **Winter Driving Tips**

To avoid becoming a statistic, follow NHTSA's top winter-driving tips:



- •Increase your following distance on bad roads especially when following a snowplow
- Pass plows with care
- •Inspect your tires, and fill them to the recommended pressure
- •Fill your vehicle's windshield washer reservoir with high-quality "winter" fluid with de-icer
- •Replace worn wiper blades
- •Test your battery and replace it if it's old or weak
- Promptly replace burned-out headlights or taillights
