Courtesy notice is hereby given that the **Cottonwood Heights Appeals Hearing Officer** will hold a public meeting to review and take possible action on six variance requests from Jeremy Williams (Hazen and Sawyer), representing the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake and Sandy, in relation to the upcoming construction of its Cottonwood Connections Project to replace an existing regional culinary water pipeline. While the extent of the application is regional in nature, you are receiving this notice as records indicate that you own property within 500' of the property owner's mailing address (3430 E. Danish Road).
