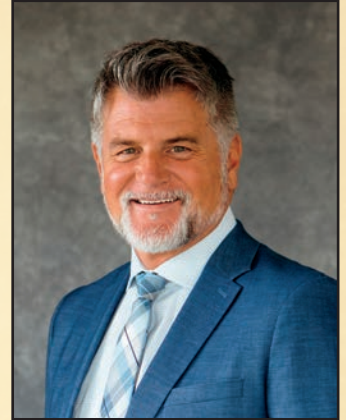
# Mayor's Message

The registration fee is \$30 for individuals or \$60 for a team.

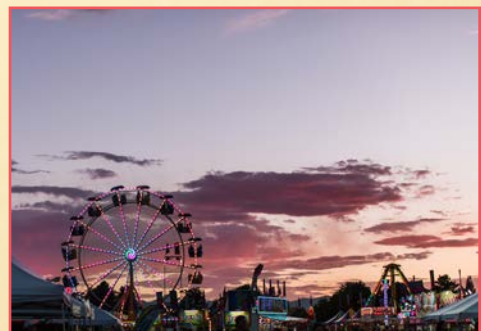

Join us for a leisurely walk (less than 1 mile) with a local historian and a member of the parks and trails committee.

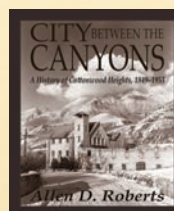

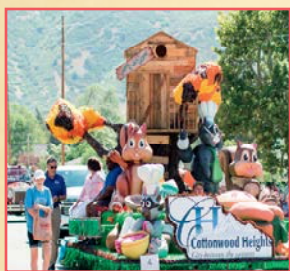
