RESOLUTION No. 2024-65

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH UTAH DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS, the Utah Department of Public Transportation ("*UDOT*") is responsible for providing for the safe and efficient movement of all modes of traffic on state highways within the state of Utah, including those within local jurisdictions such as the city of Cottonwood Heights ("*City*"); and

WHEREAS, certain portions of the roadways that provide access to Big Cottonwood Canyon and Little Cottonwood Canyon (the "*Canyons*") are state highways located within City's boundaries that are under UDOT's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, UDOT desires to increase law enforcement officer ("LEO") presence in the Canyons to aid in enforcement of traction laws and parking enforcement and has requested City to cooperatively provide certain of its LEO resources in return for funding from UDOT as described in a proposed agreement (the "Agreement") between the parties, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

WHEREAS, under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, UTAH CODE ANN. 11-13-101 *et seq*. (the "*Interlocal Act*"), any two or more public agencies may enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action; and

WHEREAS, City and UDOT are public agencies for purposes of the Interlocal Act and are empowered to enter into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, City's city council (the "Council") met in regular session on 1 October 2024 to consider, among other things, approving City's entry into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the form of the Agreement and has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of City's residents to approve City's entry into the Agreement as proposed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Agreement with UDOT is hereby approved, and that City's mayor and recorder are authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Agreement on behalf of City.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2024-65, shall take effect immediately upon passage.
